Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call

Present: Mark Horstman, President, Chris Schmaltz, Kendall Hankins, Amy Copeland, Auditor & John Ertel, County Attorney.

Maintenance – Craig Herbert

Mr. Herbert stated he is doing interviews for the maintenance position. Commissioner Horstman asked about the dispatcher room with the leak. He asked if Veregy had looked at the building yet. Mr. Horstman stated the roof has not leaked as of right now.

Treasurer – Lisa Vestal
